1. The Department of Education (DepEd) has sustained its commitment and active participation in the **Yes for Peace – Bayanihan Para sa Kapayapaan Campaign** in all public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide since 1996. Two Million Four Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand One Hundred Four (2,439,104) Filipinos participated from May 15 to September 16, 1997 while another Three Hundred Thirty Four Thousand Eight Hundred Seven (334,807) participated from October 10, 2008 to November 15, 2009 to the continuing peace education and advocacy campaign. To help establish people's support for the ongoing peace process, the DepEd distributed 10,000 copies of DepEd Memorandum No. 428, s. 2010 dated October 1, 2010. More or less Seven Hundred Twenty Thousand (720,000) responses were generated.
2. This campaign aims to encourage at least 10 Million peace-loving Filipinos, 10 years and older to speak as one to provide a democratic people's mandate for the comprehensive peace process particularly the permanent cessation of hostilities between the government and all rebel groups in 2012.
3. To inculcate the *Bayanihan* spirit and ensure that the target Ten (10) Million responses is attained from the Primary Target Audience (18 Million pupils and students from Grade IV to 4<sup>th</sup> Year), officers of Supreme Pupil Governments (SPGs), Supreme Student Governments (SSGs) in public and private elementary and secondary schools are encouraged to undertake the activities listed in the enclosure under the guidance of *Araling Panlipunan* (AP) and *Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga* (EP)/Values Education (VE) teachers and under the supervision of the school principals.
4. The following materials are enclosed for reference: (a) Enclosure No. 1- master copies of **Yes for Peace – Bayanihan Para sa Kapayapaan 2011** Questionnaires; (b) Enclosure No. 2-Homeroom Tabulation; and (c) Enclosure No. 3-School Summary Forms to be reproduced and used in the campaign.
5. Responses shall be mailed with free postage until the last week of January 2012. Results shall be delivered to the Office of the President during the celebration of the 26<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the EDSA People Power Revolution. Schools are also encouraged to hold a simultaneous *Panunumpa ng mga Kabayani para sa Kapayapaan* on **February 22, 2012 at 10:00 a.m.** or preferably during recess.

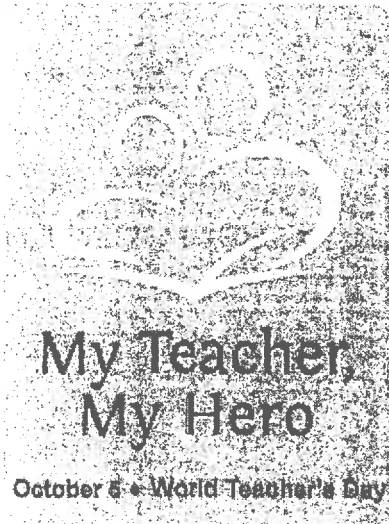

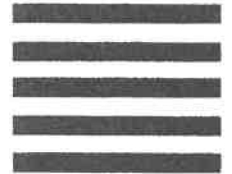

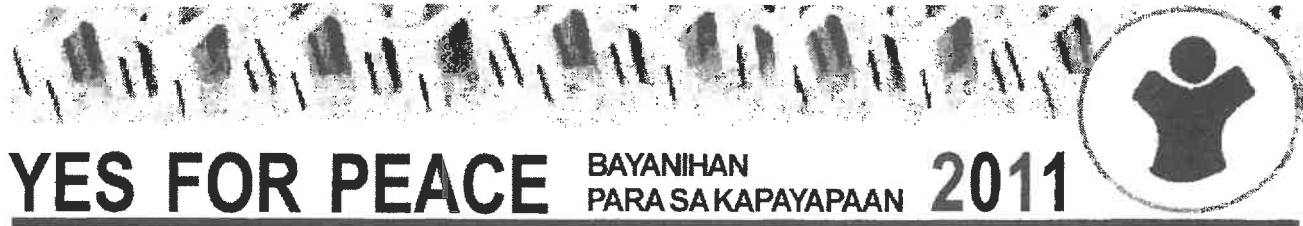

## Schedule of Activities

### I. Pre-implementation Phase

**YES FOR PEACE 2011** Volunteer Coordinators (Regional Provincial/City and Municipal) shall:

**A.** Coordinate with DepED Regional Directors, Provincial/City Schools Division Superintendents, Municipal District Supervisors to schedule meeting with Principals to set implementation strategy and schedule of implementation. *(note: Volunteers shall preferably be residents of the City or Municipality where the concerned DepED official holds office.)*

**B.** Request private sector, religious and civil society groups to sponsor the printing of **YES FOR PEACE** questionnaires, **Homeroom Tabulation** and **School Summary** forms.

*Notes:*

- No. of **YES FOR PEACE 2011** questionnaires needed = Enrollment (Grade IV to 4th Year) x three (3)
- No. of **YES FOR PEACE 2011** Homeroom Tabulation forms needed = No. of Homerooms x seven (7)
- No. of **YES FOR PEACE 2011** School Summary Forms needed = No. of Schools x seven (7)
- There are spaces in the **YES FOR PEACE 2011** questionnaires for messages of coordinators and/or sponsors.
- Sponsors may provide and post as many **YES FOR PEACE 2011** posters and similar campaign materials in allowed public as well as private places (schools, stores, residences, public markets, etc.) and stickers (tricycles, jeepneys, buses, cars, books, notebooks, etc) as they may deem needed to maximize public awareness on the campaign.

**Donations in kind shall be preferred. Cash Donations shall be discouraged.**

**C.** Coordinate with the Postmaster of the nearest Post Office to ensure that filled-up campaign materials, e.g., **YES FOR PEACE 2011** questionnaires, **Homeroom Tabulation of Responses** and **School Summary of Responses** shall be accepted as Official Business mail.

### II. Campaign Proper in Public and Private Elementary and High Schools

- **Day 1** *(From October 2011 to last week of January 2012 -- as may be determined and agreed upon by DepED Schools Division Superintendents with Principals.)*

Values Education and/or Araling Panlipunan teachers shall discuss the urgent need for people's participation in the peace process using the ten (10) questions and guide students (Grade IV to VI and 1st to 4th year) – the Primary Target Audience – in answering / filling-up of one **YES FOR PEACE 2011** questionnaire each during their Values Education and/or Araling Panlipunan period.

Students / pupils shall be assigned to bring home **YES FOR PEACE 2011** questionnaires and get the responses of their parents, out-of-school siblings, housemates, other relatives and neighbors – Secondary Target Audience.

*Notes:*

o In the worst case that there are no available sponsors, participating schools shall:

- Enjoin pupils / students to copy and answer the **YES FOR PEACE 2011** questionnaire in one whole sheet of intermediate paper.
- Photocopy required number of **YES FOR PEACE 2011 Homeroom Tabulation Forms** (7 pieces per homeroom) and **School Summary Forms** (7 pieces per school).

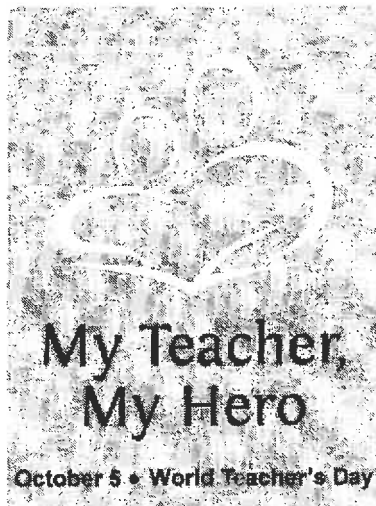
- **Day 2 & 3**

Students shall ask their parents and out-of-school siblings and housemates to each answer a **YES FOR PEACE 2011** questionnaire.

- **Day 4** *(Flag Raising Day)*

The following activities shall be conducted in all public and private elementary and high schools.

- Ten (10) student leaders / officers of Student Governments shall read one



question each before students / pupils who shall answer each question en masse during flag ceremonies.

▪ The Mayor of the Supreme Pupil Government (SPG) / President of the Supreme Student Government (SSG) shall lead the recitation of the “**Panunumpa ng mga Kabayani para sa Kapayapaan.**”

▪ Homeroom officers shall collect responses solicited by classmates from their parents and housemates.

▪ Homeroom officers shall tabulate responses and prepare seven (7) copies of **Homeroom Tabulation Responses** under the supervision of Values Education and/or Araling Panlipunan teachers.

▪ Homeroom officers shall securely pack the filled-up **YES FOR PEACE 2011** questionnaires for mailing and address these as shown:

The Homeroom officers shall submit packed responses, together with seven (7) certified **Homeroom Tabulation of Responses** to the Mayor of the SPG / President of the SSG.

▪ Officers of the SPG / SSG shall summarize the results as reflected in the **Homeroom Tabulation of Responses**.

▪ The President and the Secretary of the SPG / SSG shall prepare / certify seven (7) sets of the **School Summary of Responses** with one copy each of all **Homeroom Tabulation of Responses** under the Supervision of the School Principal.

▪ The President and the Secretary of the SPG / SSG shall fold and secure **School Summary of Responses** with **Homeroom Tabulation(s) Responses** for mailing / hand delivery to:

1. Office of the Secretary, Department of Education
2. Inter-Agency Technical Working Group c/o the Postmaster General
3. Schools Division Superintendent
4. Schools District Supervisor
5. School Principal
6. Homeroom Teacher
7. Student Government file

• **Day 5**

Officers of the SPG/SSG shall mail packed responses together with one (1) set of **School Summary of Responses** and **Homeroom Tabulation(s) of Responses** at the nearest Post Office in the presence, where possible, of Local Government Officials.

**POSTAGE IS FREE!**

• **Day 6**

Postmasters shall dispatch filled-up **YES FOR PEACE 2011** questionnaires TOGETHER with one (1) set of **School Summary of Responses** and **Homeroom Tabulation(s) of Responses** securely in M-Bags as addressed above.

**NOTE:** The above activities shall be conducted starting **September 2011** until the last week of **January 2012**.

**III. Online Gathering of Responses**

Online responses (Tertiary Target Audience) shall be generated through various social media networks (Facebook, Twitter, etc.).

An inter-active website – [www.yesforpeace.info](http://www.yesforpeace.info) – shall be established and maintained to provide updates on the campaign.

**IV. Data-Processing, Processing and Evaluation of Responses**

Results shall be summarized and evaluated as these are received by the **YES FOR PEACE 2011** Inter-Agency Technical Working Group.

**V. Delivery of Results**

Results at hand shall officially be submitted by the DepED Secretary, the Postmaster General and representatives of partner institutions to H.E. President Benigno S. Aquino III during the celebration of the **26th Anniversary of the EDSA People Power Revolution**.

All armed revolutionary groups shall be kept informed of the progress of the campaign through mass media, including online social networking sites.

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) has sustained its commitment and active participation in the **Yes for Peace**, a peace education and advocacy campaign which is adopted and incorporated as part of the *Education for All Program*, in all public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide.
2. Unfunded, the Yes for Peace campaign proved that a national consensus on peace can be established through *Bayanihan* or the pro-active involvement and collective participation of the Filipino people built upon the concepts of being inclusive, citizen-led, non-partisan, and multi-sectoral, anchored on the core values of DepEd-*Maka-Diyos, Makatao, Makakalikasan, at Makabansa*.
3. Yes for Peace was described by the EDSA People Power Commission as the *Bagong Mukha ng People Power* when the **Eleven Million Two Hundred Thirty-Six Thousand Nine Hundred Eighteen (11,236,918)** responses were symbolically turned-over and received by the government through the Presidential Adviser on the Peace Process during the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration program of the 1986 EDSA People Power Revolution.
4. Another **One Million Fifty-Three Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Eight (1,053,778)** responses were generated after February 25, 2016. On behalf of the government, Presidential Adviser on the Peace Process Jesus C. Dureza acknowledged the campaign, noted with appreciation the peace advocacy efforts of this citizen-led initiative, and congratulated its unwavering efforts in support of the peace process.
5. President Rodrigo R. Duterte has adopted the **Six-Point Peace and Development Agenda** that include *Peace promoting catch-up socio-economic development in conflict-affected areas*, and *Building a culture of peace and conflict sensitivity*.
6. Pursuant to the earnest resolve of the President to attain a just and lasting peace within his term, the Learners of the Leadership and Management Program (LAMP) of the Career Executive Service Board (CESB) issued a **Call for Bayanihan, Towards a Peaceful, Progressive, and Prosperous Philippines**, and added a social mobilization component to reinforce its education and advocacy phase of the campaign, which is now known as **Yes for Peace-Bayanihan ng Bayan**. The CESB supports the campaign to help the Philippines achieve lasting peace and prosperity, and sincerely wishes that through this, the country instills convergence and solidarity to the Filipino people.

7. Recent events have once again underscored the importance and indispensability of the following three principles underlying the peace process:

- a. A comprehensive peace process should be community-based, reflecting the sentiments, values, and principles important to all Filipinos. Thus, it shall be defined not by government alone nor by the different contending groups only, but by all Filipinos as one community;
- b. A comprehensive peace process aims to forge a new social compact for a just, equitable, humane, and pluralistic society. It seeks to establish a genuinely pluralistic society where all individuals and groups are free to engage in peaceful competition for predominance of their political programs without fear, through their exercise of rights and liberties guaranteed by the Constitution, and where they may compete for political power through an electoral system that is free, fair, and honest; and
- c. A comprehensive peace process seeks a principled and peaceful resolution to the internal armed conflicts, with neither blame nor surrender, but with dignity for all concerned.

8. To inculcate the *Bayanihan* spirit, and attain the goal and objectives of Yes for Peace among Filipinos, and to ensure that the target of at least **Thirty Million (30,000,000)** respondents to the campaign is attained from the 18.4 million school children from Grades 4 to 11 in public and private schools by **September 2017**, the officers of Supreme Pupil Governments (SPGs) and Supreme Student Governments (SSGs) are enjoined to undertake the activities listed in Enclosure No. 1, under the guidance of *Araling Panlipunan* (AP)/Social Studies and *Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao* (EsP)/Values Education (VE) teachers with the supervision of heads of public and private elementary and secondary schools.

9. The enclosed Campaign Activities shall be undertaken simultaneously in **July 2017** as may be agreed upon by the regional directors (RDs), schools division superintendents (SDSs) and district supervisors (DSs). Brief activity reports and pictures shall be prepared.

*WHEREAS, the people of (Barangay, Municipality, City or Province) have forged a clearly defined consensus or bases of unity for a just, comprehensive and lasting peace through their responses to the YES FOR PEACE – BAYANIHAN NG BAYAN campaign;*

*WHEREAS, the people of (Barangay, Municipality, City or Province) have individually committed themselves to volunteer as KaBAYANIHANs and to participate in the BAYANIHAN NG BAYAN for the convergent, integrated and holistic delivery of community-based peace and development programs and projects;*

*WHEREAS, (Barangay, Municipality, City or Province) is committed to the realization of a just, comprehensive and lasting peace;*

*RESOLVE THEREFORE, as it is hereby resolved, that (Barangay, Municipality, City or Province) is declared a ZONE OF PEACE, as herein defined:*

*A community whose constituents have agreed to:*

1. *Call for the permanent cessation of hostilities between the government and all armed groups and the realignment of funds wasted in wars of Filipinos against Filipinos to more meaningful social services such as, but not limited to, education, health, housing, poverty alleviation, countryside development and external defense;*
2. *Conduct of peace negotiations anywhere here in the Philippines instead of abroad to enable all sectors of the Filipino people and legislators to participate in drafting, approving and implementing peace agreements; and*

3. *Amendment of constitutional provisions and laws that may hinder the implementation of peace agreements.*

*RESOLVE FURTHER, that duly-elected officials of (Barangay, Municipality, City or Province) inform – by all possible means – all armed groups claiming to be fighting or protecting the rights of the people that it is has been declared a ZONE OF PEACE through this Resolution;*

*RESOLVED FINALLY, a copy of this resolution shall be submitted by mail to President RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE.*

#### • **DATA – BASING, PROCESSING AND EVALUATION OF RESULTS**

- Results shall be summarized and evaluated and as these are received by the Inter-Agency Technical Working Group.

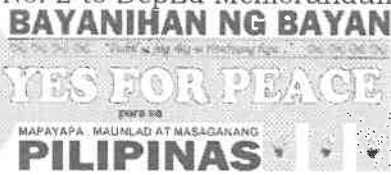

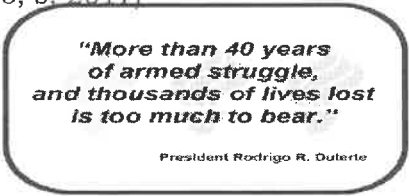
