#### YES FOR PEACE-BAYANIHAN PARA SA KAPAYAPAAN

- 1. The Department of Education (DepED) is committed to actively participate in the national implementation of the Yes for Peace Bayanihan Para sa Kapayapaan campaign in all public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide.
- 2. The campaign aims to encourage as many peace-loving Filipinos 10 years and older, to speak as one and actively support the national comprehensive peace process as well as United Nations' Resolution 53/243, "Declaration and Programme of Action on a Culture of Peace," and to reinforce and enrich the DepED's continuing peace education program.
- 3. President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo declared the month of September 2004, and every year thereafter, as the "National Peace Consciousness Month" through Presidential Proclamation No. 675.
- 4. President Arroyo thereby enjoined and encouraged all concerned Government agencies, including local government units, government-owned and controlled corporations, as well as members of private sector and civil society groups to initiate and participate in relevant and meaningful activities in celebration of the National Peace Consciousness Month. The aim is to create greater consciousness and understanding among the Filipino people of the comprehensive peace process and the Culture of Peace agenda.
- 5. In response to President Arroyo's call, the private-sector resource mobilization phase of the YES for PEACE-Bayanihan Para sa Kapayapaan campaign was launched on September 21, 2004, United Nation's International Day of Peace, at the DepED Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City.
- 6. School heads, teachers and school children from Grade IV to 4th Year of public and private elementary and secondary schools as well as representatives of the Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts, the Alpha Phi Omega and YES for PEACE are hereby enjoined to undertake the activities enclosed herewith.

#### YES FOR PEACE - Bayanihan para sa Kapayapaan

#### Schedule of Activities to be Undertaken

I. Resource Mobilization Phase (September 2007-"National Peace Consciousness Month")

The Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Girl Scouts of the Philippines and the Alpha Phi Omega Philippines Inc shall:

A. Seek sponsors for the reproduction of YES for PEACE questionnaires, Homeroom Tabulation and School Summary forms.

#### Notes:

- No. of YES for PEACE questionnaires = Enrollment (Grade IV to 4th Year) x three (3)
- No. of Homeroom Tabulation forms = No. of Homerooms x five
   (5)
- No. of School Summary Forms = No. of Schools x five (5)
- B. Coordinate the printing and distribution of YES for PEACE campaign materials solicited from sponsors with the YES for PEACE Technical Working Group.
- C. Coordinate with the Postmaster of the nearest Post Office to ensure that campaign materials, e.g. YES for PEACE questionnaires. Homeroom Tabulation of Responses and School Summary of Responses are delivered to School Principals on or before October 8, 2008.
- II. Campaign Proper (October 10 15, 2008 in observance of "Scouting Month"):
  - Day I (Friday, October 10, 2008)

Homeroom teachers shall guide students (Grade IV to VI to 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> year) in answering / filling-up of one YES for PEACE questionnaire each during their homeroom period.

Students shall be assigned to bring home YES for PEACE questionnaires and solicit the responses of their parents, out-of-school siblings, housemates, other relatives and neighbors.

Day 2 & 3 (Saturday and Sunday, October 11 & 12, 2008)

Students shall solicit responses of their parents and out-of-school siblings and housemates.

- Day 4 (October 13, 2008)
  - The Following Activities shall be conducted simultaneously in all public and private elementary and high schools.
    - 10 student leaders (or five Boy Scouts and 5 Girl Scouts) shall read one question each before students who shall answer each question en masse during flag ceremonies.
    - Homeroom advisers shall collect responses solicited by students from their parents and housemates.
    - Homeroom student leaders or Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts under the supervision of homeroom advisers, shall tabulate answers in solicited responses and prepare two copies of Homeroom Tabulation Responses.
    - Homeroom student leaders or Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts shall securely wrap the individual responses solicited by their classmates for mailing and address these as shown:

The homeroom teacher shall submit wrapped responses, together with three (3) certified **Homeroom Tabulation of Responses** to the school head.

- The school head shall summarize the results as reflected in the Homeroom Tabulation of Responses and prepare / certify three (3) copies of the School Summary of Responses and attach one (1) of copy each of all Homeroom Tabulation Responses.
- School representatives of Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts shall fold and secure one (1) set of School Summary of Responses and Homeroom Tabulation(s) Responses for mailing; forward one (1) set to sponsoring Local Government Unit of private sector / civil society group; and keep the one (1) set as file.

#### Day 5 (Tuesday, October 14, 2008)

School representative of the Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts shall mail wrapped responses together with one (1) set of School Summary of Responses and Homeroom Tabulation(s) of Responses at the nearest Post Office in the presence of Local Government Officials. *POSTAGE IS FREE!* 

#### Day 6 (Wednesday, October 15, 2008)

Postmaster shall dispatch mailed responses TOGETHER with one (1) set of School Summary of Responses and Homeroom Tabulation(s) of Responses securely in M-Bags as addressed above.

### III. Data-Processing, Processing and Evaluation of Responses (October 16, 2008 onwards):

#### October 16, 2008 onwards

Results shall be summarized and evaluated as these are received by the Inter-Agency Technical Working Group.

It is foreseen that after the "10 Million in 10 Days", the campaign will snowball until the responses of the greater majority of Filipinos, 10 years and older, shall have responded and have thus laid the general framework for open and multi-lateral peace talks between the government and all armed revolutionary forces in the country.

#### December 16, 2008

Results at hand shall officially be submitted to H.E. President Gloria Macapagal – Arroyo copy furnished the General Assembly of United Nations, the UNICEF and the UNESCO through respective representatives of the Philippines as well as the heads of armed revolutionary forces in the country.
