1. The Department of Education (DepEd) has sustained its commitment and active participation in the **Yes For Peace - Bayanihan Para sa Kapayapaan** campaign in all public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide since 1996. Two Million Four Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand One Hundred Four (2,439,104) Filipinos participated from May 15 to September 16, 1997 while another Three Hundred Thirty Four Thousand Eight Hundred Seven (334,807) participated from October 10, 2008 to November 15, 2009 to the continuing peace education and advocacy campaign.

2. This campaign aims to encourage at least 10 Million peace-loving Filipinos, 10 years and older to speak as one to provide a democratic people's mandate for the four (4) goals of the comprehensive peace process particularly the permanent cessation of hostilities between the government and all rebel groups in 2010 through the six (6) paths to peace.

3. Enclosed are master copies of **Yes For Peace - Bayanihan Para sa Kapayapaan 2010** Questionnaires, Homeroom Tabulation and School Summary Forms to be reproduced by peace loving sponsors/donors for use in the campaign and to be donated directly to schools of their choice. **Cash Donations are strongly discouraged.**

4. The school heads, teachers and schoolchildren from Grades IV to VI, and students from 1st Year to 4th Year high school from both public and private elementary and secondary schools as well as representatives of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP), the Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) and the Alpha Phi Omega (APO) International Philippines, Inc are hereby enjoined to undertake the activities enclosed herewith in coordination with the Philippine Postal Corporation (PPC) and with the assistance of the Philippine National Police (PNP).

5. The Bureau Directors, Regional Directors, Schools Division/City Superintendents/District Supervisors shall coordinate and oversee the participation of schools under their jurisdiction to the said activities and to the forthcoming PNP-initiated Peace Caravan.

I. Resource Mobilization Phase
(October 2010 onwards)

Representatives of Alpha Phi Omega, Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts, in cooperation with Chiefs of Police shall:

- A. Request Local Government Units through City/Municipal Peace and Order Councils as well as members of the private sector and civil society groups to sponsor the reproduction of YES for PEACE questionnaires, Homeroom Tabulation and School Summary forms.

Notes:

- No. of YES for PEACE questionnaires = Enrollment (Grade IV to 4th Year) x three (3)
- No. of Homeroom Tabulation forms = No. of Homerooms x five (5)
- No. of School Summary Forms = No. of Schools x five (5)

B. Coordinate with the Postmaster of the nearest Post Office to ensure that campaign materials, e.g., YES for PEACE questionnaires, Homeroom Tabulation of Responses and School Summary of Responses are delivered to School Principals on or before November 18, 2010.

II. Campaign Proper

• Day 1 (Friday, November 19, 2010)

Homeroom teachers shall discuss the urgent need for People Power in the peace process using the ten (10) questions and guide students (Grade IV to VI and 1st to 4th year) in answering / filling-up of one YES for PEACE questionnaire each during their homeroom period.

Students / pupils shall be assigned to bring home YES for PEACE questionnaires and get the responses of their parents, out-of-school siblings, housemates, other relatives and neighbors.

• Days 2 & 3
(Saturday and Sunday, November 20-21, 2010)

Students shall ask their parents and out-of-school siblings and housemates to each answer one (1) YES FOR PEACE questionnaire.

• Day 4 (Monday, November 22, 2010)

The following activities shall be conducted simultaneously in all public and private elementary and high schools.

1. Ten (10) student leaders or five (5) Boy Scouts and five (5) Girl Scouts shall read one question each before students who shall answer each question en masse during flag ceremonies.
2. Homeroom Advisers shall collect responses solicited by students from their parents and housemates.
3. Homeroom student leaders and/or Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts shall tabulate answers in solicited responses and prepare seven (7) copies of Homeroom Tabulation Responses under the supervision of Homeroom Advisers.
4. Homeroom student leaders and/or Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts shall securely pack the filled-up YES FOR PEACE using Manila Paper for mailing and address the package as shown:

5. Homeroom Advisers shall submit packed responses, together with seven (7) certified Homeroom Tabulation of Responses to the School Head / Principal.
6. School Head / Principal shall summarize the results as reflected in the Homeroom Tabulation of Responses and prepare / certify seven (7) copies of the School Summary of Responses and attach the Homeroom Tabulation of Responses.

7 School representatives of Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts shall fold and secure School Summary of Responses with Homeroom Tabulation(s) Responses for mailing / hand delivery to:

- The Secretary, Department of Education
- Inter-Agency Technical Working Group c/o the Postmaster General
- Schools Division Superintendent
- Schools District Supervisor
- School Principal
- Homeroom Teacher
- City/Municipal Peace and Order Council

• Day 5 (Tuesday, November 23, 2010)

School representatives of the Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts shall mail packed responses together with one (1) set of School Summary of Responses and Homeroom Tabulation(s) of Responses at the nearest Post Office in the presence of Local Government Officials. POSTAGE IS FREE!

• Day 6 (Wednesday, November 24, 2010)

Postmasters shall dispatch filled-up YES FOR PEACE 2010 questionnaires TOGETHER with one (1) set of School Summary of Responses and Homeroom Tabulation(s) of Responses securely in M-Bags as addressed above.

NOTE: Schools that, for one reason or another, are unable to participate in the campaign according to the above schedule are enjoined to do so as soon as possible.

III. Data-Processing, Processing and Evaluation of Responses
(November 25, 2010 onwards):

Results shall be summarized and evaluated as these are received by the Inter-Agency Technical Working Group.

IV. Delivery of Results
(December 16, 2010)

Results at hand shall officially be submitted by the DepED Secretary and heads of partner institutions to H.E. President Benigno S. Aquino III. Rebel groups shall be informed of the results through mass media.

The number of respondents to YES FOR PEACE shall be used to convince the government and all armed rebel groups to enter into a multi-lateral agreement for the permanent cessation of hostilities and the conduct of open and multi-lateral peace talks.

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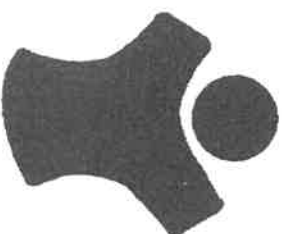
