**CORRIGENDUM AND ADDENDUM TO DECS MEMORANDUM NO. 393, S. 1996  
AND DECS MEMORANDUM NO. 170, S. 1997**  
(**Diyes for Peace - Bayanihan Para sa Kapayapaan and KAMPANA**  
(**Karahanan at Masama, Pawiin Natin))**

1. The DIYES FOR PEACE -- Bayanihan para sa Kapayapaan campaign jointly being implemented by DECS, the Philippine Postal Corporation, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines and the Girl Scouts of the Philippines has been extended to November 17, 1997, World Peace Day. Results of the campaign shall then be delivered to H.E. President Fidel V. Ramos.
2. Relatedly, the National Social Action Council (NASAC) will undertake KAMPANA (Karahanan at Masama, Pawiin Natin!), a human chain -- from the Northern tip of Luzon to the southern tip of Mindanao -- also on November 17, 1997 to assert the Filipino people's absolute desire for an enduring peace and unqualified rejection of all forms of violence.
3. To ensure the successful implementation of the campaign through the education sector, the following institutions will participate: a) Department of the Interior and Local Governments; b) National/Local Peace and Order Councils; c) Philippine National Police; d) Citizens Crime Watch; e) VFP-Sons and Daughters Association, Inc., and f) Alpha Phi Omega.
4. Regional Directors, Schools Division Superintendents and District Supervisors shall designate part-time coordinators in their respective areas of jurisdiction. Names of designated coordinators shall be mailed, not later than 22 October 1997, to:

5. Designated regional, division and district coordinators shall attend the symposium in the venue nearest to their respective areas of assignment as per the attached implementation schedule.
6. Designated regional, division and district coordinators shall take the lead in coordinating with local representatives of the institutions enumerated above. They shall follow the attached Implementation Guide.
7. Assistance in the production of DIYES FOR PEACE campaign forms and other information materials may be solicited from civic organizations, private corporations or individuals. DIYES FOR PEACE campaign forms may be reproduced through offset printing, risograph printing, or other similar means of reproduction. Contributors and donors may be acknowledged in space provided for in the campaign form. **Cash contributions are discouraged.**
8. Regional Directors, Schools Superintendents & District Supervisors are enjoined to monitor compliance and include performance, specifically the number of responses solicited per school for the DIYES FOR PEACE and number of participants mobilized for KAMPANA, in their annual reports.
9. Principals and Teachers shall use the Implementation Guide and *Gabay para sa mga Guro at Punong-Guro* in: a) explaining the importance of the campaign; b) tabulating responses; and c) mailing responses and tabulation forms.
10. All pupils from Grades IV to VI and students from first to fourth year high school in both public and private schools shall be guided by teachers in answering the campaign forms. They shall also be assigned to solicit the responses of their parents and other relatives. They shall be discouraged from soliciting responses outside their respective homes.
11. Attached are the following for information and guidance: a) Implementation Guide; b) Sample DIYES FOR PEACE Campaign Form; c) *Gabay para sa mga Guro at Punong-Guro*; d) Sample Tabulation Form; e) DECS Memorandum No. 393 s. 1996; f) DECS Memorandum No. 170, s. 1997; g) Postmaster General's Memorandum; h) KAMPANA information brochure; i) National Peace & Order Council (NPOC) Chairman's Memorandum to Peace & Order Councils; and j) NPOC Chairman's Memorandum to PNP units.
12. Dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum and compliance thereof by all concerned is expected.

## **IMPLEMENTATION GUIDE**

*DIYES FOR PEACE -- Bayanihan para sa Kapayapaan &  
KAMPANA -- Karahasan at Masama, Pawiin Natin!*

The DIYES FOR PEACE — Bayanihan para sa Kapayapaan is a youth and student sector led peace initiative developed and test implemented at the University of the Philippines System.

It was enriched based on provisions of Executive Order No. 125 issued by President Fidel V. Ramos on September 15, 1993. EO 125 defined that, "a comprehensive peace process should be community-based, reflecting the sentiments, values and principles important to all Filipinos. Thus, it shall not be defined by Government alone, nor by the different contending groups only, but by all Filipinos as one community".

EO No. 125 also stated that, "a comprehensive peace process aims to forge a new social compact for a just, equitable, humane and pluralistic political society. It seeks to establish a genuinely pluralistic political society, where all individuals and groups are free to engage in peaceful competition for predominance of their political programs without fear, through the exercise of rights and liberties guaranteed by the political power through an electoral system that is free, fair, and honest."

Among others, EO No. 125 mandated the following: a) mobilization and facilitation of people's participation in the peace process; b) peaceful, negotiated settlement with the different rebel groups; and c) building and nurturing a climate conducive to peace.

Its national implementation was adopted by the 4th National Peace and Order Summit as a strategy to address the root causes of insurgency.

Results of the DIYES FOR PEACE campaign will be delivered to President Fidel V. Ramos on November 17, 1997 -- World Peace Day.

The DIYES FOR PEACE campaign seeks to non-violently assert that, "The Filipino people's will is sovereign. It is the true power in Philippine affairs," and to address the root causes of insurgency by establishing the framework of peace negotiations. It shall harness the collective efforts of peace advocates, students, professionals, workers, government officials and volunteers in soliciting responses from at least 10 Million Filipinos to a set of ten (10) questions.

Respondents shall each be asked to answer ten (10) questions and express their individual views on the general concepts expressed therein and provide basic personal and postal information.

To assert the Filipino people's absolute desire for an enduring peace and unqualified rejection of all forms of violence, the National Social Action Council (NASAC) will undertake KAMPANA (Karahasan at Masama, Pawiin Natin!), a human chain -- from the Northern tip of Luzon to the southern tip of Mindanao also on November 17, 1997.

KAMPANA is a logical sequel and fitting highlight to the DIYES FOR PEACE campaign. It is a non-partisan, nationwide, people-based activity that would unmistakably and palpably manifest the Filipino people's absolute desire for an enduring peace and unqualified rejection of all forms of violence including drug abuse, poverty and injustice.



The major route shall traverse Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, La Union, Pangasinan, Tarlac, Pampanga, Bulacan, Metro-Manila, Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Quezon, Camarines Norte, Camarines Sur, Albay, Sorsogon, Northern Samar, Samar, Leyte, Southern Leyte, Surigao del Norte, Agusan del Norte, Agusan del Sur, Davao del Norte, Davao del Sur, South Cotabato and Sarangani.

Filipinos in provinces and regions that are not part of the main route can organize their own chains to link with the main route or send delegations thereto.

Probable branches are: from Ilocos Norte to Cagayan; from Cagayan to Bulacan; from La Union to Baguio; from San Fernando, Pampanga to Olongapo and Cabanatuan; from Agusan del Norte to Zamboanga del Sur; and others.

Island provinces like Cebu, Negros, Panay, Palawan, etc., can organize their own chains.

Special prominence shall be given to Centennial historical landmarks to enhance public awareness on the call for unity made by the revolutionaries of 1898.

### OBJECTIVES

1. To bring the Filipino people into the center stage of the national peace process and revitalize the Bayanihan spirit.
2. To mobilize at least 10 million Filipinos -- 10 years and older -- to speak as one and help: a) forge the basis of our unity; b) find peaceful means to establish a non-violent society; c) contribute towards ending the armed conflicts; d) pave the way towards a just, comprehensive and lasting peace; and e) commit themselves to the empowerment of the Filipino people.
3. To guide all pupils from Grades IV to VI and students from first to fourth year high school in both public and private schools in answering 10 questions on various general issues affecting peace and providing basic personal and postal information.
4. To mobilize pupils and students in soliciting the responses (filled-out DIYES FOR PEACE

campaign forms) from their parents and other relatives.

5. To mobilize approximately 3.0 million Filipinos to light candles and join hands to form a Human Chain stretching approximately 2,500 kms. along the Pan-Philippine highway from Pagudpud, Ilocos Norte in Luzon to Glan, Sarangani in Mindanao on November 17, 1997.
- The collective action of various organizations — from across the political spectrum and from all levels of the socio-economic strata — for these purposes will assert the Filipino people's mandate for all armed groups invoking our name to adopt peaceful and non-violent means towards social reforms and possibly heal the wounds and unite the nation.

2. Field representatives and members of the lead institutions, agencies and organizations shall be enjoined -- by their respective heads -- to actively help organize these activities and encourage multi-sectoral citizens' participation.

3. Other groups actively involved in the ongoing peace process -- including but not limited to representatives of the forces involved in the armed internal conflicts, e.g., Government of the Republic of the Philippines - Armed Forces of the Philippines (GRP-AFP); Rebolusyonaryong Alyansang Makabansa (RAM); National Democratic Front - Communist Party of the Philippines - New People's Army (NDF-CPP-NPA); Moro National Liberation Front (MNLF); Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) -- will be invited to participate in these activities.

4. Production and delivery of campaign forms and other materials -- including the *Gabay para sa mga Guro at Punong-Guro* -- to schools.

5. Conduct of school level orientation and coordination activities by school heads, teachers and representatives of participating institutions, agencies and organizations.

**03 November 1997**

Start of DIYES FOR PEACE campaign in all schools.

1. Elementary Schools and High Schools

- a. Teachers will guide school children answering the 10 questions and in filling-up campaign forms during the *Gawaing Pagpapaganda ng Ugali or Hekasi (Geograhiya, Kasaysayan at Sibika)* period.

- b. Teachers will assign all schoolchildren to bring home campaign forms and ask their parents and out-of-school siblings/housemates to accomplish these.

2. Colleges/Universities

- a. Room to room campaigns will be conducted by volunteer fraternity and sorority members in cooperation with

The non-partisan thrust and multi-sectoral nature of these initiatives is expected to encourage participation from various religious organizations, political parties and non-government organizations from across the political spectrum and from all levels of the socio-economic strata.

### IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE

Implementation schedule of the campaign follows:

#### First week of October 1997

Mailing of DECS Memorandum and information materials to all schools and DILG Memorandum to local government units (provincial, city and municipal).

#### 10 to 20 October 1997

National and local chapters/units of participating agencies, institutions and organizations will collectively facilitate the:

1. Organizational meetings of participating institutions, agencies and organizations in various levels -- national, regional, provincial, city, municipal and barangay -- shall be conducted to:

1.1 Discuss objectives of the complementary (DIYES FOR PEACE & KAMPANA) projects.

1.2 Clarify/distribute tasks:

a. Local Government Units/Peace and Order Councils (Regional, Provincial, City, Municipal and Barangay) - provide population (10 years and older) data per area and provide assistance in production and distribution of DIYES FOR PEACE campaign forms and other materials.

b. Department of Education, Culture and Sports (Regional, Division, District, Schools) - conduct campaign among pupils (Grade IV to VI) and students (first to fourth year high school) and among parents. Tabulate, summarize and mail responses.

- c. Philippine Postal Corporation - provide postal and other related services
- d. Other Organizations/Institutions - provide assistance in production and distribution of campaign forms and other materials.

## CAMPAIGN SYMBOL

The *Sinarapan* (Pandaka Pygmaea) — the smallest freshwater fish in the Philippines featured in ten (10) centavo coins until the 1994 series — is the rallying symbol of the campaign. Before our "Creator", we are all equally small fish as implied by Jesus Christ — the Lord and Savior of Christians, the Greatest Prophet of Muslims and one of the Best Philosophers of Agnostics — when He called on the Apostles to join Him "to be fishers of men".



## CAMPAIGN SLOGAN

The campaign slogan is: DYES FOR PEACE – Bayanihan para sa Kapayapaan.

The rallying call is the number 10 (DYES) to underscore the following:

1. The phrase — DYES FOR PEACE — rhymes and appeals to easy memory recall.
2. Respondents are expected to answer YES to all questions posed — 'Di-YES FOR PEACE'.
3. The campaign will involve Filipinos 10 years old and above.
4. 10 years is legally defined as the age of discernment. People are normally expected to have a sound sense of what is wrong and right at this age.
5. 10 is the age when a person who continuously attended school is expected to have learned how to read, write and comprehend.
6. The responses to the 10 questions of the campaign will be used to define the basis of national unity and establish the foundations of an era of a just, comprehensive and lasting peace.
7. The number 10 is universally accepted as a number of perfection.
8. There are 10 Commandments recognized by all religions in the Philippines.
9. The campaign gained substantial momentum in 1996 — the first year after the 10th since the EDSA phenomenon
10. The campaign was launched in 1996 — the closing year of the 10th decade of the Philippine Revolution.
